## Meeting the 24/36 Hour Rule

After completion of the second semester term or third quarter term of attendance and from then on, a student must have accumulated a minimum of 24 institutional credit hours in the two immediately previous terms of attendance in a semester system or 36 institutional credit hours in the three immediately previous terms of attendance in a quarter system.


12 Attempted Hours = Full-Time Term

## Meeting the 24/36 Hour Rule with Non-Term Hours

Non-Term hours must be earned in between or after the two most recent full time terms. A maximum of 12 non-term hours can be used for the 24/36 Hour Rule.


Non-Term Hours = summer, inter-term, or part-time earned hours.

## Meeting the 24/36 Hour Rule with Full Withdraw

Withdrawals (W's) on transcripts are equal to attempted credit.
