

## Lithuania

### Educational Timeline

- School year: September-June, Graduation occurs in June
- Primary school is four years followed by six years of lower secondary, followed by two years of secondary school depending on track. Four-year gymnasiums admit applicants who have completed eight years of education.

### GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by converting *Brandos Atestatas* grades line-by-line. Each grade is weighted equally. Convert to US equivalents and then to quality points. Divide quality points by the total number of examination results included.

### Class Ranking

Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student's final position in the student's secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students).

## Post-Secondary Education

Students will be charged terms of attendance and considered transfer students if they have enrolled as a regular student and attended one or more courses at any of the types of institutions listed below (may not be all inclusive) or any other institution that requires proof of high school graduation as a pre-requisite for admission (subject to review on a case-by-case basis).
