Educational Timeline

- School year: September to June; Graduation occurs in June
- Primary school (Dimotiko) is six years followed by 3 years of lower secondary school (Gymnasio/Gymnasium) followed by three years of upper secondary (Eniaia Lykeia or Technical Vocational Educational Schools (TEE))

Group A: Documents That Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Students presenting documents other than those listed below will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis

Απολυτήριο Ενιαίου Λυκείου / Apolytirio Eniaiou Lykeiou Upper Secondary School Certificate
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcript for three years of upper secondary school

Απολυτήριο τεχνολογικού επαγγελματικού εκπαιδευτηρίου / Apolytirio Epangelmatiko Lykeio Upper Secondary Vocational School Diploma
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcript for three years of upper secondary school

Τεχνικά Εκπαιδευτήρια δίπλωμα / Technika Epangelmatika Ekpedeftiria (TEE) Technical-Vocational School Diploma
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcript for three years of upper secondary school

Group B: Documents That Do Not Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Comparable to less than completion of US high school

Απολυτήριο γυμνασίου / Apolytirio Gymnasiou Lower Secondary School Certificate

GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by converting line-by-line all grades listed on *Απολυτήριο Ενιαίου Λυκείου* (Upper Secondary School Certificate) weighting each value equally. Convert to US equivalents and then to quality points. Divide quality points by the total number of courses and exams attempted.

Grading Scale (May not be all inclusive):

Numeric Grade	US Grade	Quality Points
18.1-20	A	4
13.1-18	B	3
9.5-13	C	2
0-9.4	D	1 lowest passing grade
0-39	F	0

Class Ranking

Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student's final position in his/her secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students). However, students completing tracked or separate degree programs (e.g. *Τεχνικά Εκπαιδευτήρια δίπλωμα*) must be ranked against all other students in a given class who completed the same degree program.

Post-Secondary Education

Students will be charged terms of attendance and considered transfer students if they have enrolled as a regular student and attended one or more courses at any of the types of institutions listed below (may not be all inclusive) or any other institution that requires proof of high school graduation as a pre-requisite for admission (subject to review on a case-by-case basis).
