Educational Timeline

- School year: September to June; Graduation occurs in June
- Primary school is six years followed by three years of lower secondary school followed by two, three, or four years of upper secondary school

Group A: Documents That Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Students presenting documents other than those listed below will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis

-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for three years of upper secondary school	
<i>Sashualo Specialuri Sastsavleblis Diplomi</i>	Special Secondary School Certificate
-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for three years of upper secondary school	
Sashualo Ganatlebis Atestati	Certification of Secondary School Education
-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for two or three years of upper secondary school	
Prophesiul-Teknikuri Sastsavlebis Diplomi	Vocational-Technical School Diploma
-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for two or three years of upper secondary school	
Prophesiul-Teknikuri Sastsavlebis Danartit	Vocational-Technical School Diploma with Supplement
-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for three or four years of upper secondary school	

Group B: Documents That Do Not Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Comparable to less than completion of US high school

GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by converting line-by-line all final overall exam results listed on the Group A documents listed above. Each grade is weighted equally. Convert to US equivalents and then to quality points. Divide quality points by the total number of examination results included.

Class Ranking

Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student's final position in his/her secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students). However, students completing tracked or separate degree programs (e.g. *Prophesiul-Teknikuri Sastsavlebis Diplomi*) must be ranked against all other students in a given class who completed the same degree program.

Post-Secondary Education

Students will be charged terms of attendance and considered transfer students if they have enrolled as a regular student and attended one or more courses at any of the types of institutions listed below (may not be all inclusive) or any other institution that requires proof of high school graduation as a pre-requisite for admission (subject to review on a case-by-case basis).
