Educational Timeline

- School year: September to June; Graduation occurs in June
- Primary school (*Educación Primaria*) is six years followed by three years of lower secondary school (Ciclo Básico) followed by three years of upper secondary school (*Ciclo Diversificado*)

Group A: Documents That Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Students presenting documents other than those listed below will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis

Bachiller/Bachillerato

High School Diploma

-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts (*Certificado de Promoción*) for three years of upper secondary school

Bachiller/Bachillerato with a specialization

High School Diploma with Specialization

(e.g. Humanidades, Ciencias)

-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts (*Certificado de Promoción*) for three years of upper secondary school

Bachillerato Técnico/Commercial

Vocational High School Diploma

-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts (*Certificado de Promoción*) for three years of upper secondary school

Maestro Normal

Teaching Diploma

Basic Technician

-Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts (*Certificado de Promoción*) for three years of upper secondary school

Group B: Documents That Do Not Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Comparable to less than completion of US high school

GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by converting line-by-line all grades listed on each of the three *Certificado de Promoción* (one for each year of upper secondary school) to US equivalents and convert to quality points. Divide quality points by the total number of courses attempted. If an average, or *promedio parcial de rendimento/nota promedio* is given for all three school years, take the average of the three yearly *notas promedios* and convert to US equivalent and then to quality points. If a *numerical calificación* (overall grade) is listed on the diploma issued by the Ecuadorian Ministry of Education, convert that overall grade to a US equivalent and then to quality points.

Class Ranking

Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student's final position in his/her secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students). However, students completing tracked or separate degree programs (e.g. *Bachillerato en Humanidades*) must be ranked against all other students in a given class who completed the same degree program.

Post-Secondary Education


