

Bosnia and Herzegovina

Educational Timeline

- School year: September to June; Graduation occurs in June
- Primary school is eight years followed by four years of secondary school

Group A: Documents That Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Students presenting documents other than those listed below will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. The title of the document may vary depending on the canton.

Sviedočanstvo Svjedodžba o Završnom Ispitu Certificate of Completion of Secondary Education
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for four years of secondary school

Svjedočanstvo Svjedodžba o Završenom Obrazovanju Certificate of Completed Education
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for four years of secondary school

Diploma o Položenom Maturskom Ispitu Diploma of Completed Maturity Examination
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for four years of secondary school

Diploma o Završenoj Gimnaziji Diploma of Completed High School
 -Must be accompanied by academic records/transcripts for four years of secondary school

Group B: Documents That Do Not Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Comparable to less than completion of US high school

Sviedočanstvo Svjedodžba Certificate

GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by taking the average of the overall results provided on each yearly grade report (*Svjedodžba*) and the final exam overall result (listed on the "Group A" document), weighting each value equally. Convert to US equivalents and then to quality points.

Grading Scale (may not be all inclusive)

Class Ranking

Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student’s final position in the student’s secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students). However, students completing tracked or separate degree programs must be ranked against all other students in a given class who completed the same degree program.

Post-Secondary Education

Students will be charged terms of attendance and considered transfer students if they have enrolled as a regular student and attended one or more courses at any of the types of institutions listed below (may not be all inclusive) or any other institution that requires proof of high school graduation as a pre-requisite for admission (subject to review on a case-by-case basis).
